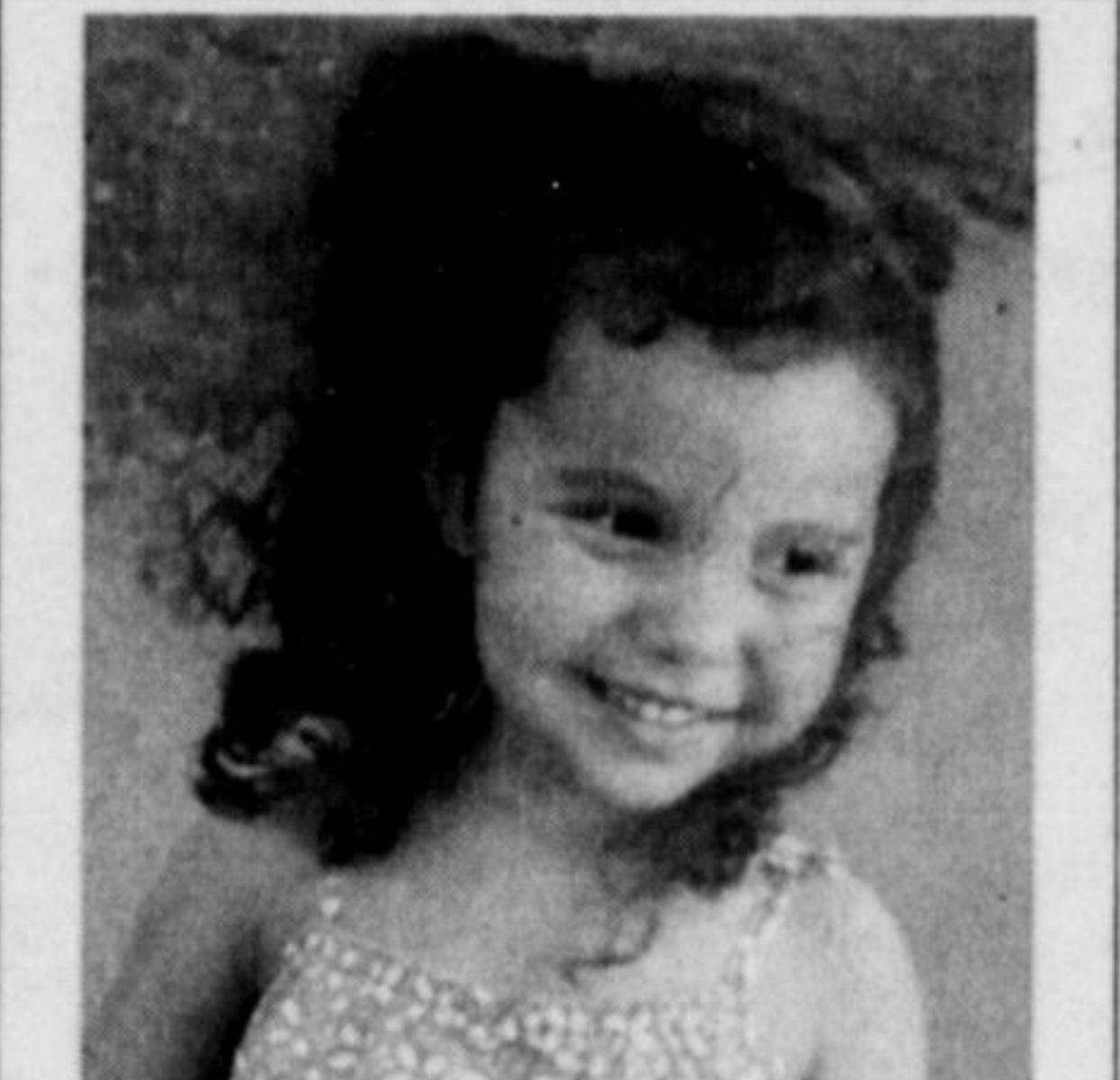
**HAYNES, Dorothy**

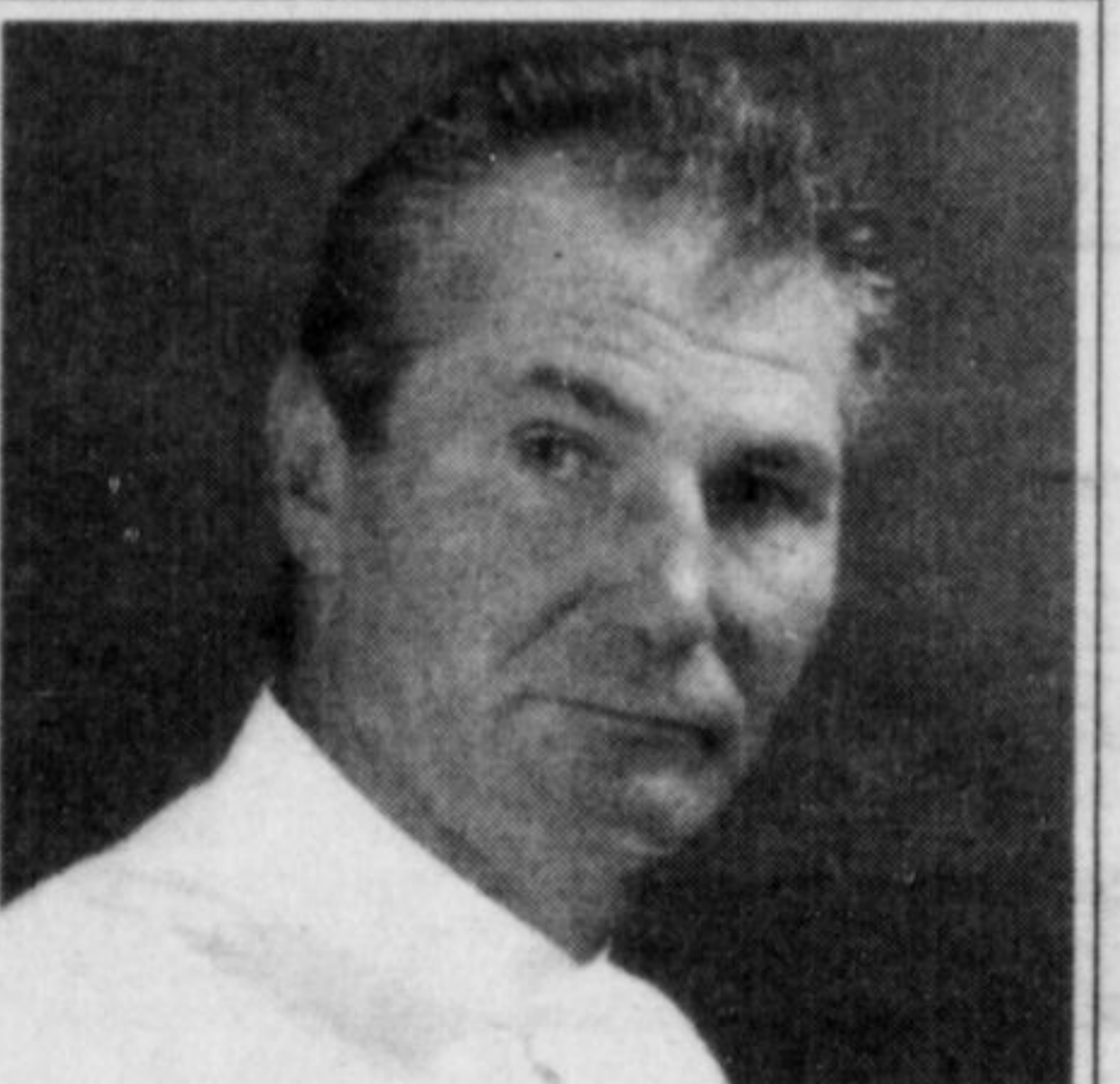

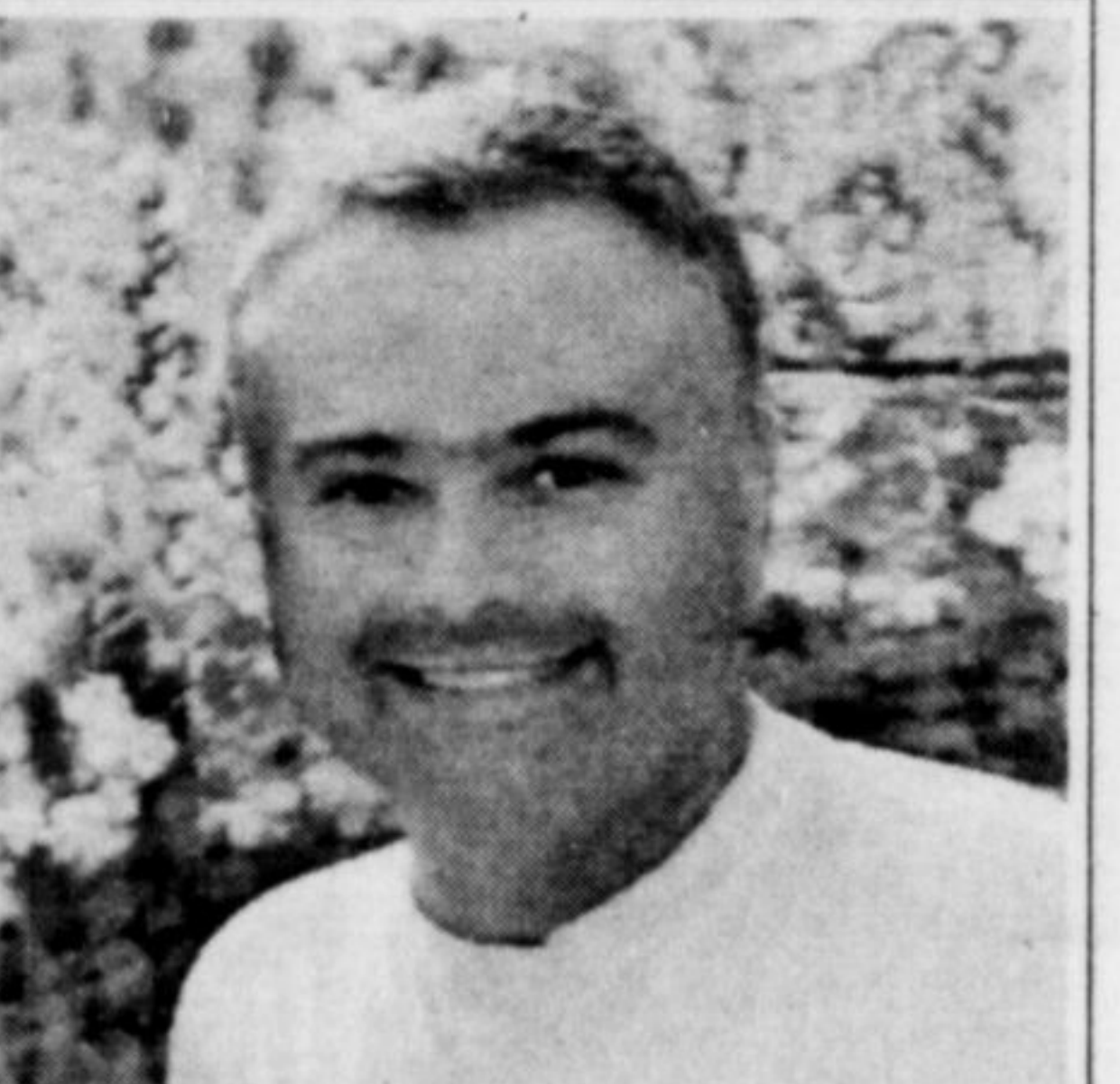
**FLEET, Abbygale August Jacklyn**
