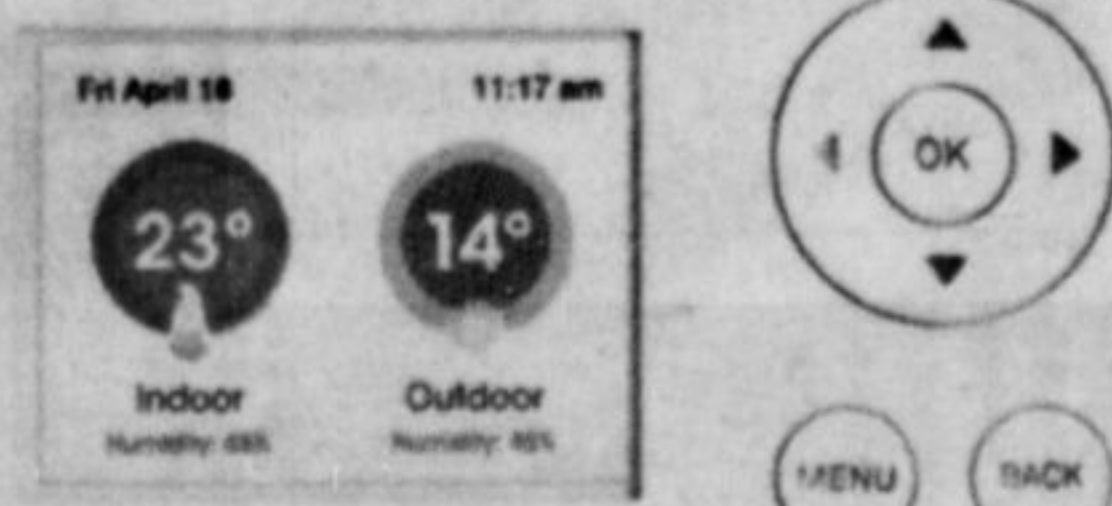

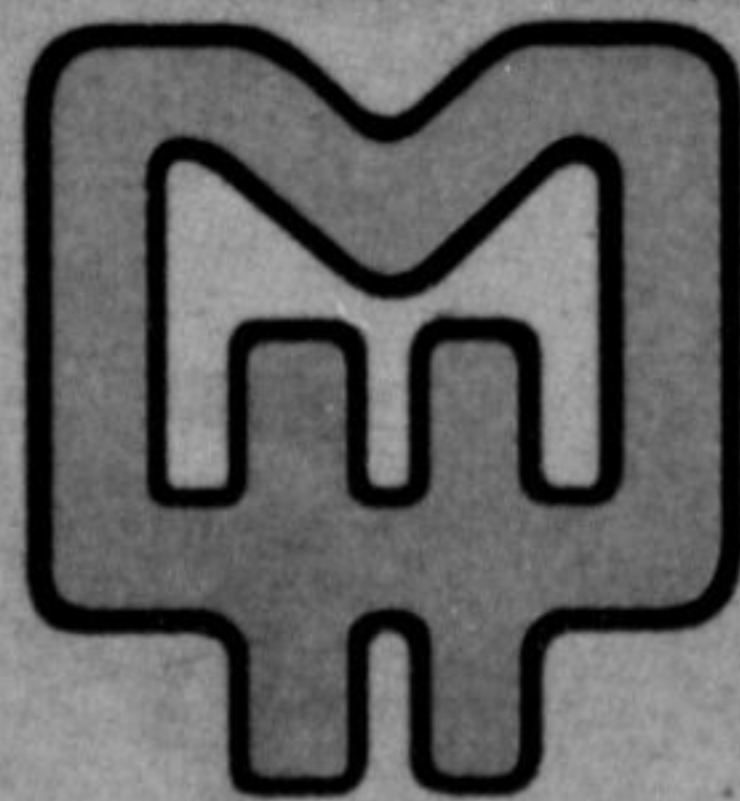

Funding 'great news': Halton MPP

• Halton Region Conservation Authority — \$45,226
• Town of Oakville — \$1,922,379
• City of Burlington — \$1,166,883
• Town of Milton — \$650,370

The Province announced in February 2014 local governments and conservation authorities would be fully compensated for all eligible disaster response and recovery costs. Halton MPP Indira Naidoo-Harris said the funding was "great news" for the community. "I'm pleased that the Ontario government is responding to the devastating impact of the

2013 ice storm," she said. "This funding will help cover damage-related costs and support Ontario families who were severely affected by the storm." The Ice Storm Assistance Program was created to assist with the costs related to immediate emergency response and subsequent cleanup efforts. Halton's local governments and conservation authority are among the approximately 55 other institutions across Ontario that will receive interim payments of approximately one-third their claim.

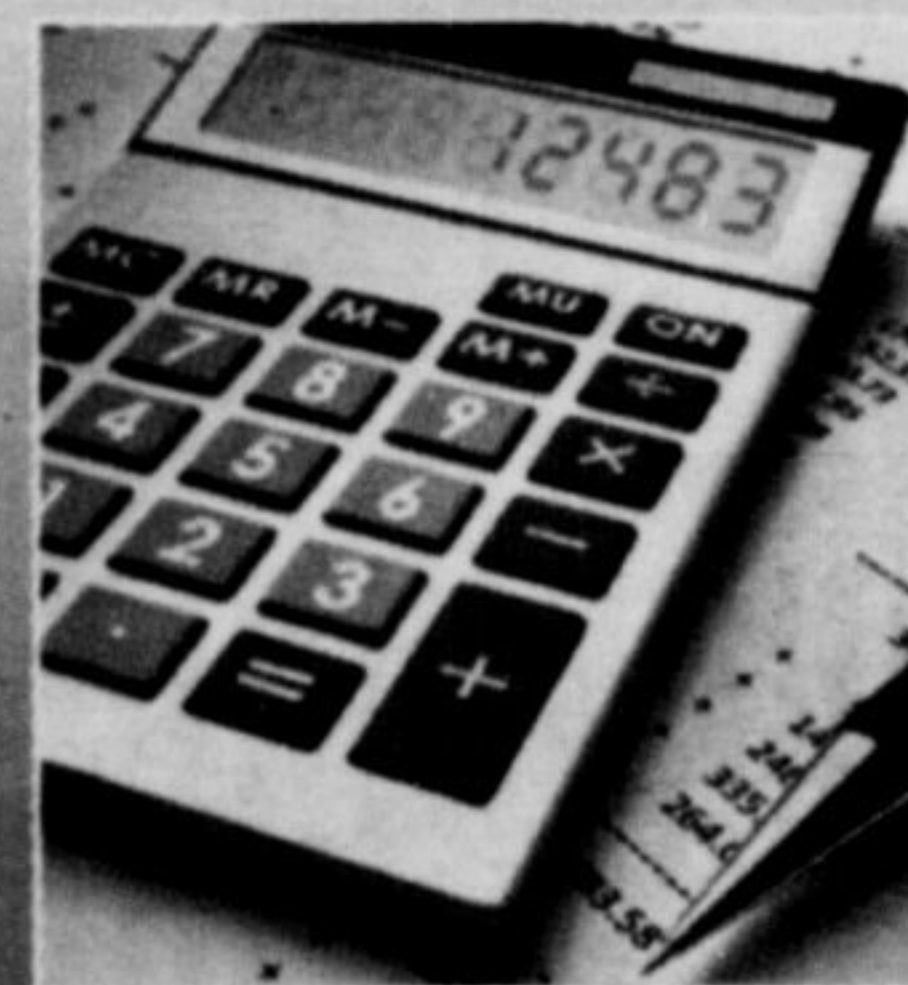
