And of course, concert-goers will likely hear Arden's career breakout hit Insensitive in 1994. In fact, Arden has released 12 albums with 19 top-10 singles.

Arden's current concert tour has seen her on the road for almost a year from one end of the country to the other promoting her latest CD, Everything Almost, which was released in 2014. Some have touted the album as being among her finest work, calling it progressive, yet retaining her distinctive voice and fromthe-heart lyrics.

Arden said she has remained true to herself from the start.

"The last 25 years has been completely surreal to me," she said. "I bought property outside the city (Calgary, where she was born) and my parents live 50 feet from me.

"I don't ever take anything for granted. I know statistically, it was totally against someone like me getting anywhere."

She said she has continually written from the heart and based on how she's feeling, not what's going to get radio time.

"I never spent one day thinking 'what's radio going to like?" she said.

At the same time as touring, Arden said she's also trying to complete a novel she's been working on for two years; she's already penned three books.

"I'm just trying to decide who lives and dies, but it's been an absolute adventure to write," she added.

Arden also penned an advice column for Elle magazine and she was a broadcaster as host of Being Jann, an hour-long talk show on CBC Radio in 2010.

Arden has also hosted The Social, a CTV daytime program. She has narrated the popular program ER Vets and she has produce two documentaries, Free and Jann Takes Manhattan. She also toured with the Vagina Monologues across Canada.

She has also become well known for her hilarious adventures with fellow Canadian Rick Mercer on the CBC's The Rick Mercer Report.

Arden said she was surprised to learn on the latest episode that Mercer had been at Milton's new velodrome.

"Man, I'm glad I wasn't at that one," she laughed.


