**Bald eagle spotted in Milton**

A Milton woman captured a photograph of a bald eagle perched in a tree on Britannia Road, west of Tremaine Road, on February 10. Louanne Fuller was travelling with her husband John Fuller when she spotted the bald eagle high in the tree, blue sky in the background.

According to Conservation Halton's Julia Mar-ko Dunn, who's a natural heritage ecologist, bald eagles regularly overwinter in Halton, but not in large numbers.

She said the conservation authority has some records of observations of bald eagles at Hil-ton Falls and Mountsberg in the last few years. "Bald eagles are a wonderful success story," she said. "After a severe decline in population over many decades caused by DDT use, and an absence of any breeding records for the species from the north shore of Lake Ontario for decades, their populations have rebounded and there is even a pair that has bred at Cootes Paradise."

Burlington's Royal Botanical Gardens (RBG), which has a bald eagle monitoring project in place, confirmed bald eagles have over-
