The Halton Waste Management Site (HWMS) provides Halton residents with a convenient "one stop" location for reuse, recycling and proper waste disposal.

- ✓ Go to the Scalehouse upon arrival.
- ✓ Secure all open loads with a tarp or rope.
- ✓ Loads must be sorted by material type. Pre-sort loads for quick and easy unloading.
- ✓ Remove all fluids (e.g. gas, oil) from gas powered equipment such as lawnmowers.
- ✓ Arrange for additional assistance to help unload heavy material, if required.

Fees

For general waste and use of the Container Station, the user fees are:

- up to 50 kg – \$5/load
- 51 kg - 150 kg – \$10/load
- over 150 kg – \$157/tonne starting from 0 tonnes

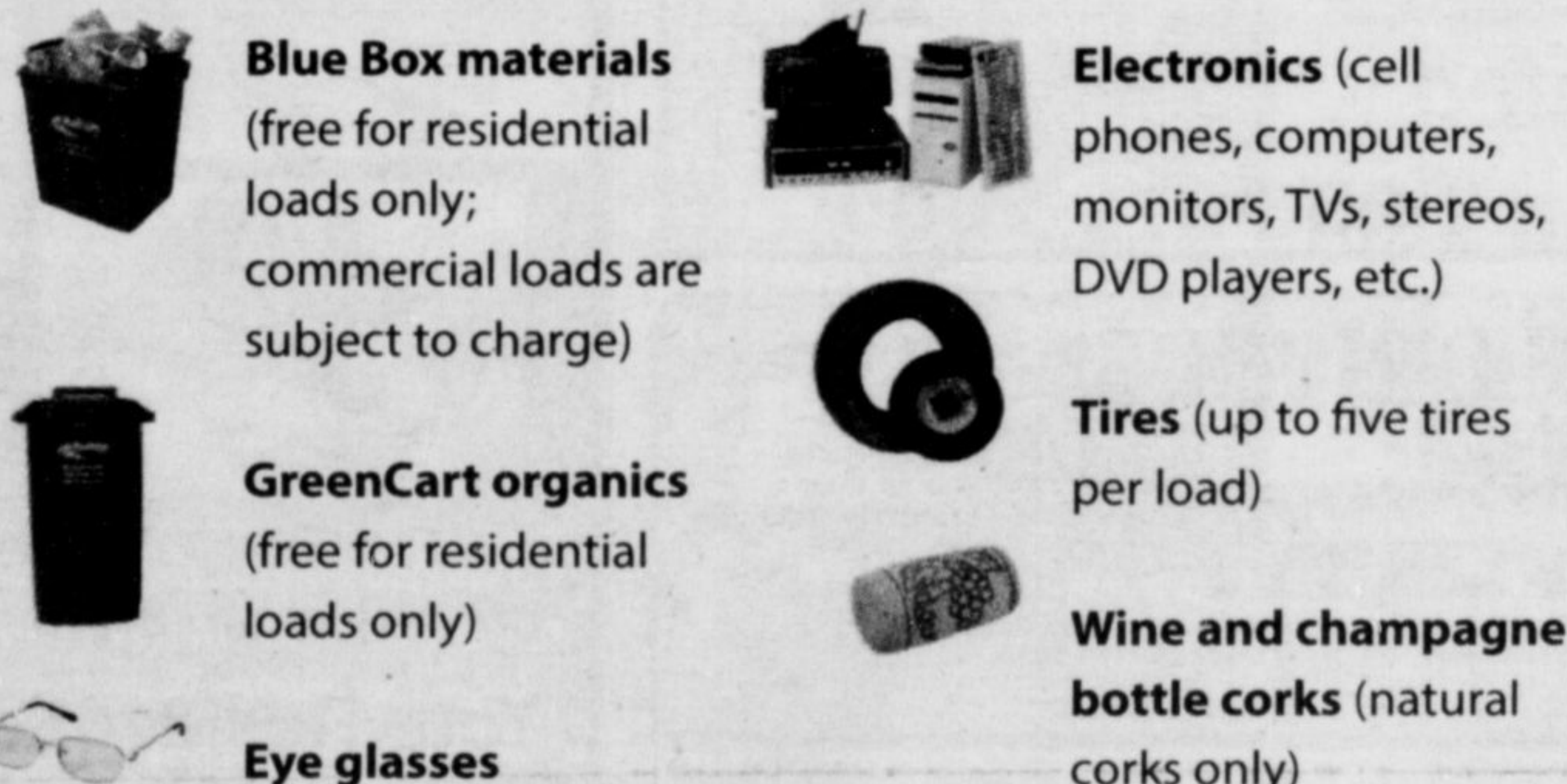

Paint & Stain Reuse Depot

Looking to repaint a room? Pick up and drop off useable paint and stain at the Paint & Stain Reuse Depot for free. The Paint & Stain Reuse Depot is conveniently located beside the Household Hazardous Waste Depot and is open from spring to fall. The HWMS cannot guarantee the availability of colours or quantities.



Salvation Army Reuse Depot

Drop off unwanted reusable items free of charge and help the community.



- ✓ **Acceptable Materials:** clothing, linens, paired shoes, belts, purses, antiques and books, working electronics (e.g. TVs, stereos, radios, VCRs, CD players, DVD players), kitchenware, clean and undamaged furniture.



- ✗ **Unacceptable Materials:** cabinets, desks, typewriters, tires, auto parts, mattresses, infant equipment (e.g. cribs, strollers, car seats).



Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Depot

Household hazardous waste can injure waste collectors and can damage the environment if disposed of improperly. Household hazardous waste must not be put in the garbage or poured down the drain.

There is a 20 litre maximum per visit. No commercial hazardous waste can be accepted.

Acceptable (No charge)

- ✓ Acids (rust remover)
- ✓ Aerosol cans (full or partially full)
- ✓ Antifreeze
- ✓ Batteries (household and car)
- ✓ Bleach
- ✓ Cosmetics and pharmaceuticals
- ✓ Fluorescent light (compact bulbs and tubes) 8 max.
- ✓ Fertilizers
- ✓ Fuels (must leave container)
- ✓ Garden chemicals
- ✓ Household cleaners
- ✓ Medications
- ✓ Mercury containing devices
- ✓ Motor oil and filters
- ✓ Paint (full or partially full)
- ✓ Pesticides
- ✓ Pool chemicals
- ✓ Propane tanks and other pressurized containers
- ✓ Sharps (needles, syringes, lancets)
- ✓ Solvents
- ✓ Stains
- ✓ Varsol
- ✓ Waste vegetable cooking oil

Unacceptable

- ✗ Commercial Hazardous Waste
- ✗ Explosives
- ✗ Radioactive waste
- ✗ PCB waste
- ✗ Bio-medical waste
