

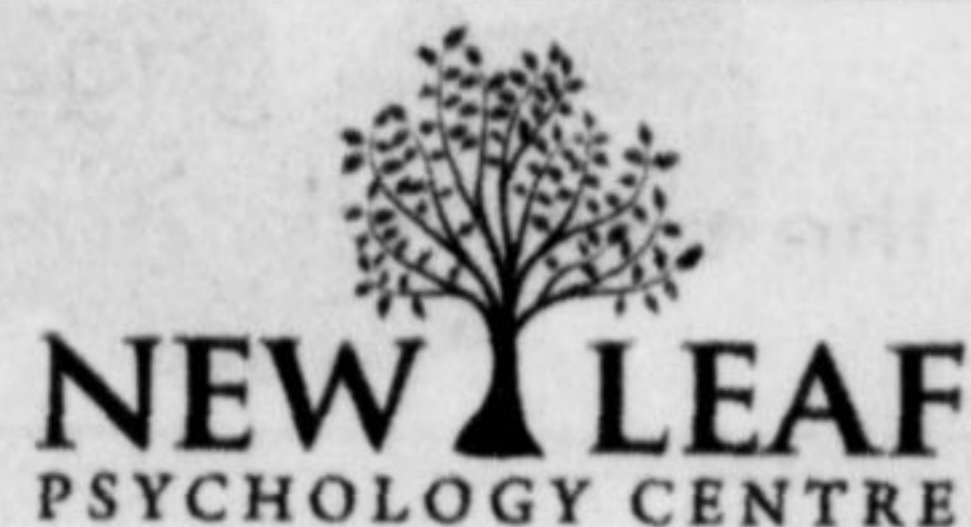
# Suspects sought in assault, victim suffered minor injuries

Halton police are seeking the public's assistance in an assault that occurred last month in Milton.

Police say that on Saturday, Apr. 18 at approximately 11:30 p.m. a 37-year-old man was walking northbound on Ontario Street, just north of Laurier Avenue, when he passed a group of five or six men.

He was pushed to the ground and assaulted, sustaining minor injuries.

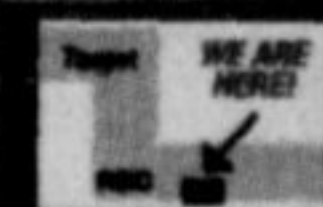
