No merit to lawsuit: Town of Milton

TSI's claim over development should be dismissed, reads statement of defence

A \$150-million lawsuit filed against the Town of Milton, Mayor Gord Krantz and two town

staffers is "completely without merit", according to the statement of defence. Almost a month after a statement of claim was filed by Mississauga-based real estate company TSI International Ltd. over a chunk of land adjacent to Campbellville, town staff has responded by calling the lawsuit "excessive" and one that "should be dismissed". The statement of claim alleges that the defendants — the Town, Krantz, CAO Bill
