## Arrests down, suspensions up during festive RIDE program

Halton police said arrests for impaired driving were down around 45 per cent this holiday season.

During the Halton police Decem-= ber RIDE (Reduce Impaired Driving Everywhere) campaign officers stopped more than 15,000 vehicles. During these stops they arrested 31 people for impaired driving, which ਰਂ is down from the 56 impaired driving arrests made last year.

Suspensions issued for blowing a

"warn" on an alcohol screening device were up this year with police handing down 46 three-day suspensions.


This is a 65 per cent increase from 28 in 2014.
