

Town receives quarterly OLG payment

The Town of Milton has received its quarterly payment from the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation for hosting OLG Slots at Mohawk Racetrack. The third-quarter non-tax gaming revenue payment of \$1,059,651 was made on January 21. "This is great news for Halton," said Halton MPP Indira Naidoo-Harris. "Funds generated from the OLG gaming sites

allow us to reinvest in local priorities and this means more money for more Halton infrastructure projects and important community organizations. "These funds also benefit all of Ontario through vital public services like health care and education." Since August 1999, Milton has received more than \$94.7 million in non-tax gaming revenue.

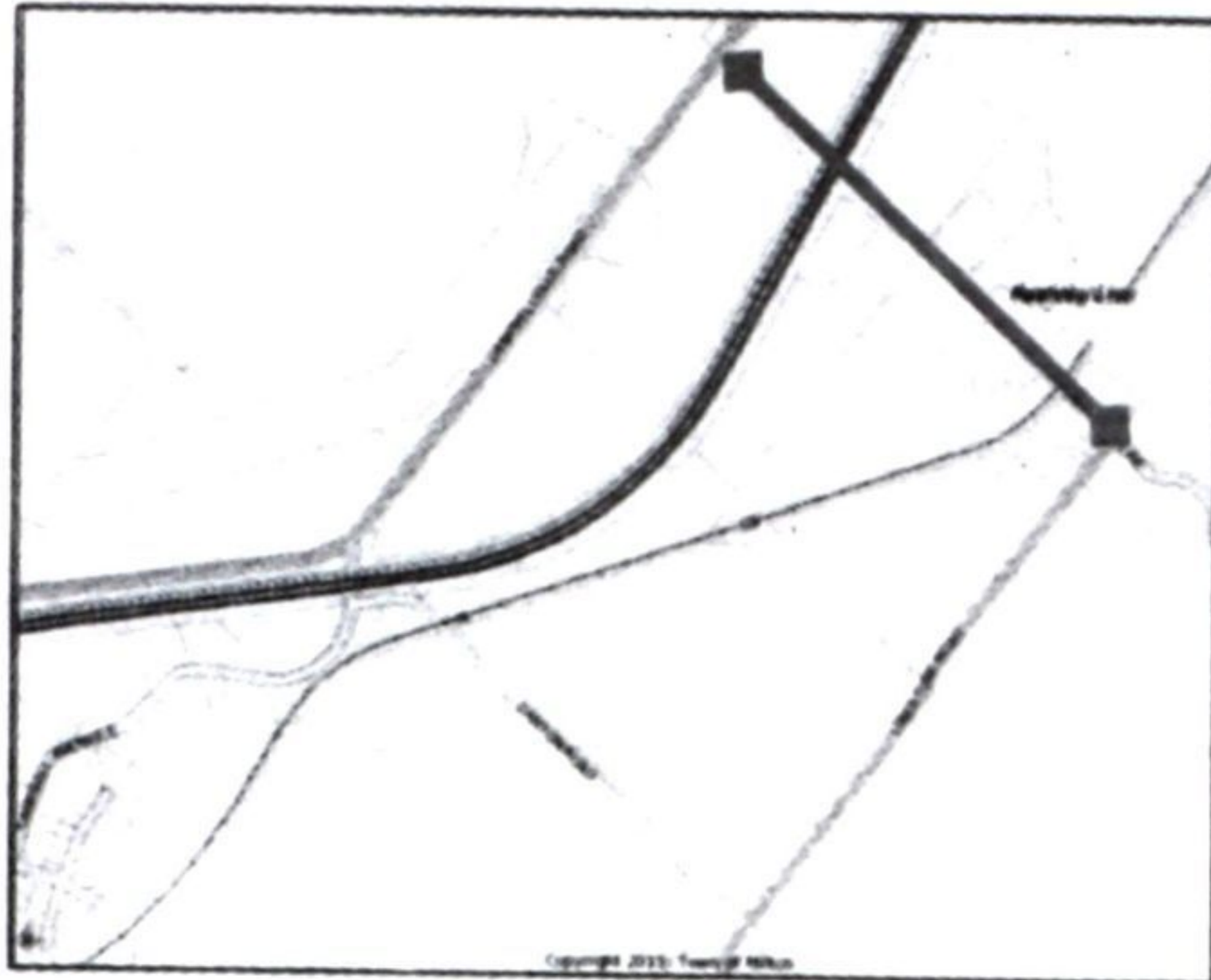
