

## Liquor still discovered in bush near Speyside

Time Capsules are gems of information extracted from past issues of the Champion and other publications in order to provide a window into Milton's past.

#### Sept. 1921

On Saturday, Chief Officer Edward Flood, of the Inland Revenue Department of Ontario, accompanied by a member of the Dominion Mounted Police, visited the site of a liquor still in the bush near Speyside about half way between the first and second lines. Ample evidence was found that a still had been in operation there but most of the outfit had been removed a short time before the officers reached the place.

It is reported that the still was operated by a man who lives in Milton, and that the product of the plan was distributed at various points in the county and out of it by motor cars at night — Acton Free Press

The town hall was packed last Monday afternoon by delegates to the convention of the Halton People's Political Association and spectators. There were many women and the members of the new party were full of enthusiasm. The Premier (Drury) was greeted by five minutes of applause. He declared that the meeting marked an epoch in the history of the country. It was the first convention of the People's party, he said, ever held in the Dominion of Canada to choose a candidate for the Federal House.
