Notice of Temporary Road Closure Fourth Line between Derry Road and Clark Boulevard

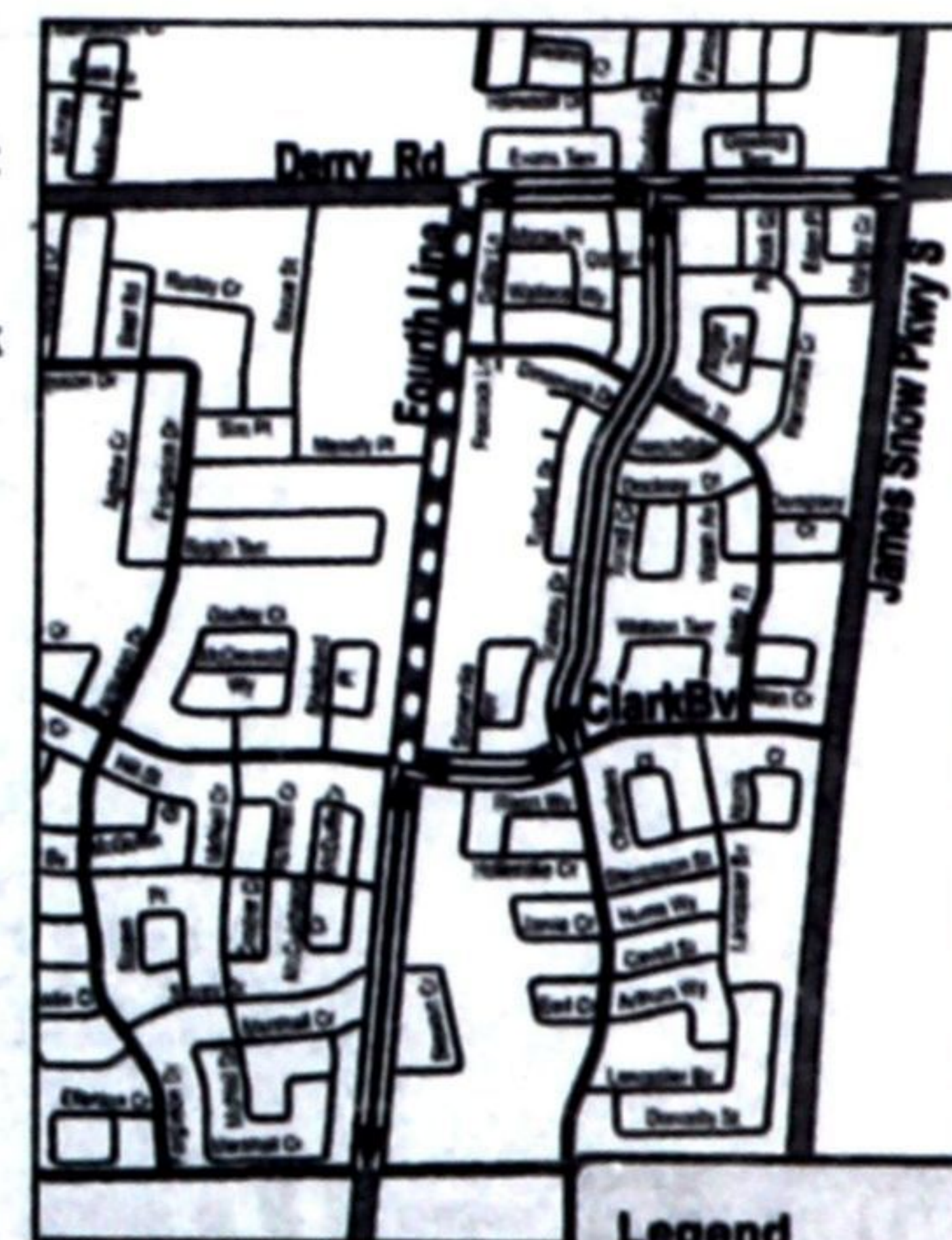
