Back-to-back tournament titles for bantam Mets

Tournament success was in ample supply for the bantam Mets late last month.

Milton closed out July with its second tournament title in as many weekends, reigning supreme in Orillia.

The Mets steamrolled to the final — winning four games by no less than seven runs apiece — before battling to a 5-3 victory over the Sudbury Shamrocks.

Oliver Reyes delivered six-plus solid innings to pick up the win, while Mitch Enns led offensively with two hits and two RBI. Cain Richards and Dom King also drove in runs.

The unbeaten weekend included lopsided round-robin wins over Guelph (11-1), Orillia (7-0) and North York (17-5) before a 13-2 semifinal rout of West Mountain.



Reyes, Enns and Cooper Thompson shared the mound work, while contributions came from up and down the lineup.

This followed the Mets' B side championship victory at the Muskoka Cup, where after a humbling 10-0 mercy at the hands of Leaside they rallied with four straight wins for the consolation

title.

The last of those victories came in a roller-coaster 9-8 squeaker over Orangeville, who despite losing four players to injury rallied from a six-run deficit to throw some suspense into the late stages of play.

Reyes was the winning pitcher and highlighted things at the plate with a two-run homer and double.

Other RBIs came from Thompson, Dylan Michaud and Ben Austin.
