PATTERSON, Gordon William (Bill)

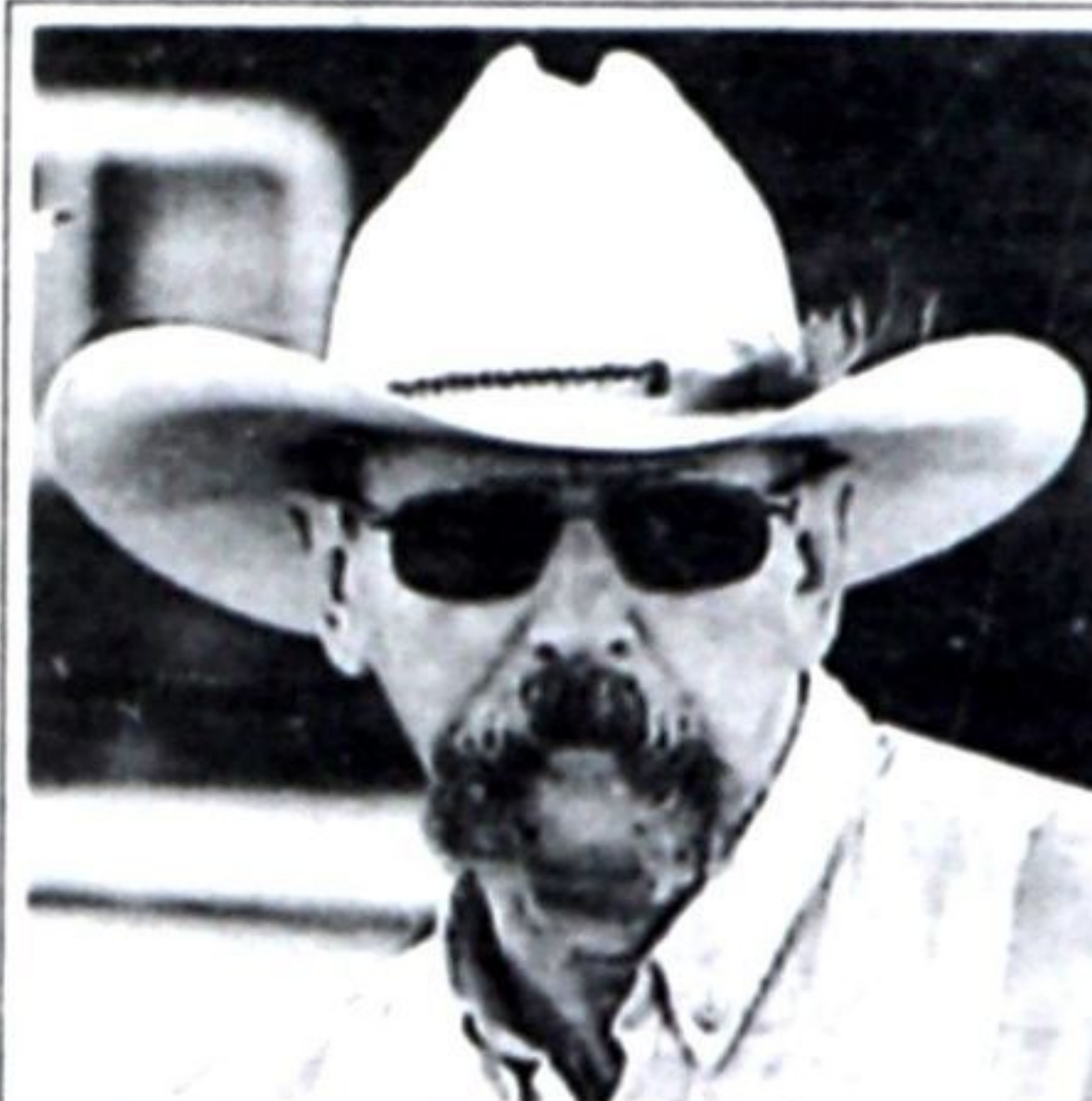
1932 - 2017
