# Visitors to get a sneak peek of new hospital at open house

Constructors Canada Inc. The project, which is on time and on budget, saw more than 40 PCL crews influence "an outstanding safety culture that sent over 600 tradespeople home safely every day, with over 1.2 million hours worked without a lost time injury," said the company.

The project, said PCL Toronto district manager Kelly Wallace, "is a tremendous example of the power of collaborative teamwork." With full access to the expansion, which is connected to the existing facility, hospital officials are preparing the new space for occupancy.

This is a significant undertaking that involves extensive cleaning, setting up workstations and equipment, stocking supplies, testing and commissioning of building systems and technology, and orientation and training for all staff, physicians and volunteers. "There is a tremendous amount of work still to be done to ensure we are ready to provide exemplary patient care on opening day," said

Hardenne. That day is set for Sunday, Oct. 1. Community residents won't have to wait that long to get a sneak peek at the shiny new hospital wing. Community open houses are planned for September, when Milton residents will be invited to tour inside the new expansion. Dates for the open house will be announced in August.

While substantial completion has been reached, some work on the northwest corner of the Derry Road and Bronte Street property is still outstanding, including the construction of new parking lots and driveways.

To facilitate this work, the hospital's entrance and driveway off Derry Road has been closed. The hospital is now accessible from driveways and hospital entrances located at 725 Bronte St. S.
