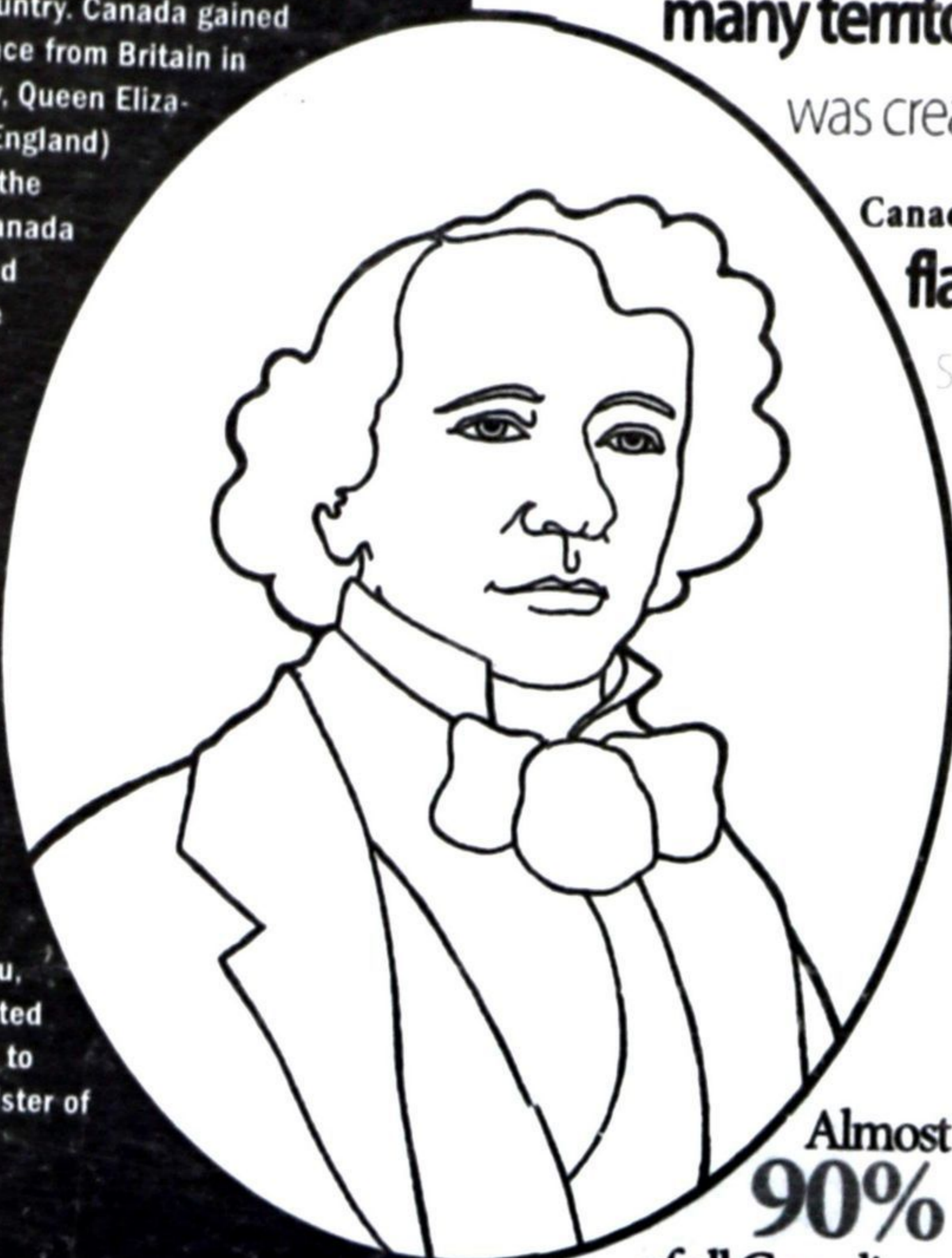

Historical Tidbit

Canada's biggest bay, Hudson Bay, was discovered in 1610. Since the 16th century, both French and English kings have ruled over the country. Canada gained independence from Britain in 1867. Today, Queen Elizabeth II (of England) is still also the Queen of Canada and the head of state. The first prime minister of Canada was Sir John A. Macdonald, and the current prime minister elected by the people is Justin Trudeau. Justin's father, Pierre Trudeau, was also elected by the people to be prime minister of Canada.
