

are to number from East to West from Number one to twelve inclusive and the Concessions from South to North from number one to six inclusive.

The Concession lines are to be run due East and West, astronomically, and the Side lines at right angles thereto, or due North and South, astronomically. The lines to be surveyed are marked in Red on the projected plan. You will commence the survey at the South East angle of the Township, which is also the South West angle of Badgona, & North West angle of Caldwell, by running due West for the length of your first Concession, planting your posts at regular intervals thereon.

In performing the survey, your lines must be well opened and blazed. You will plant firmly in the ground at the front angles of the lots, durable and substantial posts of the dimensions given in the "General Instructions" taking care to mark, with a proper marking tool, the number of the lots on the East and West sides thereof, and the number of the Concession on the North side thereof, the Concessions being single numbered. You will not mark on the South side the posts between lots one and two, three and four, five and six &c. in any of the Concessions, as these posts have no reference to the lots South of them, but form the starting point for their respective Side lines, which will be drawn parallel to their several governing lines.

You will not lay out any Concession or Side road allowances. In those parts of Concessions which form Lakes, you will be careful to plant the posts at the proper points along the Shore. You will obtain by calculation, or offsets, in the field, all widths of Lakes, rivers &c. cut by your Concession or Side line run by you, which cannot be measured, in the usual way, and will run the same in your Field book on the page on which it occurs, in order that a satisfactory check of your work, may be made by this offset.

All waters within the limits of your survey must be surveyed and connected with your lines of Survey, whether such waters are cut by the Concession or Side lines run by you or not.

In carrying out this survey you will conform closely with the "General Instructions," a copy of which is herewith enclosed for your guidance.
