George Locke, one of the founders of the OLA and its President in 1917 became the second Canadian to be President of the American Library Association in 1926. The ALA conference in his term was held in Toronto and for the occasion, he created a souvenir booklet called "Gossip!" These illustrations on the cover and the illustration for the "Taste of the Decades" reception appeared in this booklet. University of Guelph librarian Lorne Bruce wrote an article about this pamphlet in the v. 5, no. 2 Winter 1999 issue of Access. It made for good reading and led to the decision to use the material here.
