Rumour has it that the Hon. Janet Ecker may be making a major announcement at the

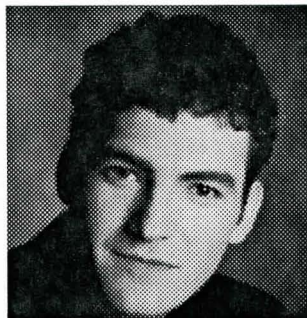
