Room locations

The location where each session takes place is on the first line of each session description as well.

MTCC 204B indicates that the session is located in the Metro Toronto Convention Centre. All 200 numbers are on the street level. All 100 numbers are below ground down the escalator. Sections B, D or F are entered through the main hallway. Sections A, C or E are entered from the narrower hallway at the back.

ICH indicates that the session is in the Intercontinental Hotel. All meeting rooms in the hotel have a name rather than a number. Ballroom A or B, Niagara and Ontario are below ground down the escalator. All other rooms are entered through the glass doors on the east side of the lobby.
