Throughout his seminar, Mr. Booth focused on how the definition of literacy has changed in reaction to technological changes in our society. He stressed the need for libraries to react and meet the new literacy needs of students by shifting from a focus on print to a balance of print, computers and the internet.

The traditional view of reading and how this relates to males in our society is a particular passion of Mr. Booth. He spiritedly encouraged



librarians to accept that boys and men have unique literacy interests, and discouraged the societal view that you are not a reader if you are not reading novels.

Changes in Literacy was worth the wait and Booth himself proved very wellinformed and entertaining.
