

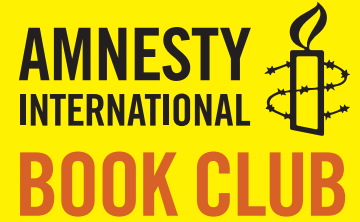
# DID YOU KNOW ABOUT THE AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL BOOK CLUB?
