- Teacher / peer conference notes
- Keywords for searches
- Rough drafts
- Tracking sheet recording possible resources

- Organized point-form notes (e.g. charts, mind maps)
- Booklet of your work
- Internet addresses and printouts
- Evaluations including personal evaluations
