 - increased circulation
 - success stories from students and teachers
 - more teachers borrowing library resources to support classroom instruction
 - collaborative discussions with teachers about the use of these resources
 - more effective instructional units
 - book clubs overflowing
 - students and teachers asking for more
 - thank you notes and stories
