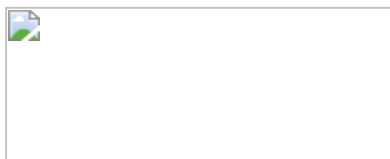

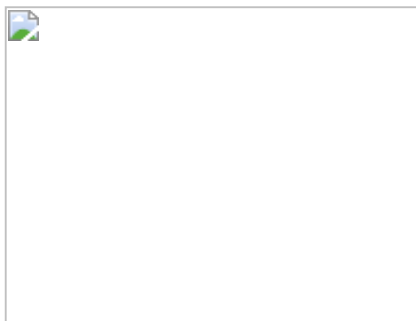
Save the date! This year's symposium will take place on **Friday December 4, 2015** at Hart House in Toronto. More program details coming soon.

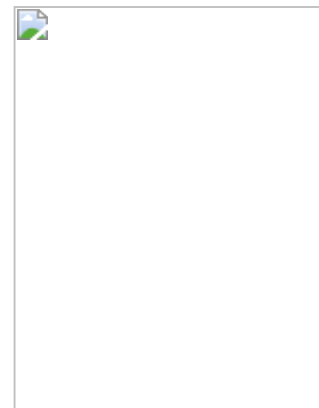
