# Ontario Budget Announcement: April 27

Charles Sousa, Minister of Finance, will deliver the 2017 Ontario Budget on Apr. 27. The budget will outline target investment areas in Ontario and thus may impact Ontario's libraries.

It is also expected that the Minister will announce selected ideas in the Ontario Budget Talks consultation. Earlier this year, OLA partnered with FOPL to submit an idea on <u>expanding</u> <u>connectivity in rural, northern and Indigenous communities.</u>
