# Notice of nomination to the CFLA-FCAB Board of Directors, 2020 – 2021 (two-year term)

The Ontario Library Association is a member association of the <u>Canadian Federation of</u> <u>Library Associations/Fédération canadienne des associations de bibliothèques (CFLA-FCAB</u>). The CFLA-FCAB by-law stipulates that as a multi-sector provincial association in the Central Canada (ON) region, OLA is eligible to put forth a candidate for election to the CFLA-FCAB board of directors.
