the Government of Canada's Connecting Families initiative (CFi) has seen nearly 30,000 Canadian families connected to \$10 Internet and the same amount of refurbished desktop computers delivered.

During its inaugural year, the CFi sent 360,000 letters to eligible low-income families inviting them to sign up, and an additional 162,000 letters were distributed in September 2019. They anticipate that many of these new families do not currently have access to a computer or the Internet and will likely come to a library for help in signing up through the online portal.

A <u>step by step guide</u> has been prepared for these instances, that will help staff and volunteers <u>walk through the online</u> <u>portal</u> with a family and help to answer questions that may arise in the process. The Chinese American Librarians Association (CALA) Canada Chapter invites you to celebrate the success of this new Chapter and share your knowledge and experience as library professionals with Chinese cultural background. There are a wide range of topics being proposed for this half day program, from EDI initiatives, leadership development to literacy programs, library research, and projects.
