SPRING ASSIZES, ORIGINAL. The Assizes opened at Original on Thursday last, before Hon. Mr. Justice Wilson, when the following gentlemen were sworn in as Grand Jurors:—

William Allison, Foreman; Colin Cameron, Alfred Cass, James Callaghan, Edward Charles, James Hughes, Charles Hunter, Charles Mackenzie, Donald McIntosh, John McQuaker, Thomas McQuaker, Antoine Quesselle, John Rowan, Jonathan Sherman, Robert S. Macdonald, Esq.

The Crown witnesses were called by E. T. Dartnell, Esq., County Attorney. The criminal business was light, there being but one prisoner for trial on a charge of manslaughter. The civil business was also light.

His Lordship briefly charged the Grand Jury and congratulated them on the general absence of crime in the counties of Prescott and Russell, in which respect, it took precedence of most counties in Canada, the prisoner now in custody being the only one committed for trial for many months.

The several crown witnesses were then called on their recognizances, and respectively returned to the jail, and the civil business proceeded with there were but four cases on the calendar.
