His Excellency the Governor-General in
Council.

WHEREAS, by the Fortieth Chapter
of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, in
the year of our Lord One thousand and
fifty-one, it is aforesaid other things enacted, that "The
Governor in Council may from time to time make
such Regulations as he thinks proper for the
construction and maintenance of the buildings
and such other works as may be required under
this Act, and for ensuring the due performance of Quarantine
by and in respect of Vessels, Passengers, and Goods
coming into the Port of Quebec, and for
the thorough cleansing and disinfecting of such Vessels,
Passengers, and Goods, and for the
interception or dissemination of disease
into or from this Province, and may from time to
time revoke, alter or amend such Regulations,
and such Regulations shall have the force of law dur-
