Toronto, June 1st, 10 a. m.

There is an immense excitement here.

The Fenians, 2,000 in number, are reported to have burned and destroyed a large amount of property.

They have cut the telegraph wires, and thus cut off the source of communication.

The various volunteer companies are turning out, and preparing to move at a moment's notice.

About 500 of the Queen's Own have left for Fort Colborne, and the 10th Royals will leave at 10 o'clock; they are now mustering.

The Field and Garrison Batteries of Artillery are also mustering. The whole population are enthusiastic, and a continual line of them are on the streets rushing to their respective armories.

Refugees from Fort Erie, who have arrived at Brantford, report the burning of the Sorewin's Bridge, about five miles west of Fort Erie. Nothing new elsewhere.

They are being armed and equipped, and all appear anxious to meet the spoiler.

The latest report is that they have left Fort Erie and are marching on Chippewa.

A collision will no doubt shortly take place. Every precaution is being taken to secure peace.

The volunteers at Hamilton, London, Galt, Guelph, Ingersoll, Berlin, Waterloo, Brantford, Paris, and throughout the country, are steadily pouring in, and preparing for the conflict. There is a perfect whirlwind of enthusiasm exhibited everywhere.

Citizens Patrolling the Streets.

An Armed Vessel on Lake Ontario.

Cavalry ordered to the Frontier.

The Fenians are Robbing Money.

Gen. Napier Leaves for the Front.

Toronto, 2nd, 2 o'clock a. m.

At a mass meeting of the citizens this afternoon, resolutions were passed, and a patrol of 200 to-night 400 citizens are patrolling the streets.

A large propeller with armed men is said to be on the lake, and it is rumored will cross the Lake. The guns of the old fort command the west entrance to the harbor.

The factory of the Royal Artillery, which was ordered to the front, has been kept here in case it was needed.

The Naval Brigade are guarding the drill shed and other parts of the city.

Telegrams are received every half hour by the military authorities from the front.

An attack will be made at daylight, and the military authorities are on the alert.

A foraging party of Fenians approached Chippewa last night, but made a retrograde movement. They are seizing horses, and some other property.

The Governor General's body guard has been ordered to the front. The 10th Cavalry is at Chippewa, with the whole British force.
