His EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOV-  
ERNMENT OF CANADA.His EXCELLENCY was pleased to lay  
before the Council a Report from the Com-  
missioner of Customs, dated 15th December, 1865, and  
agreed that under authority of chapter 17 of the Con-  
stit. Can., Sec. 24, an Order in Council was passed on  
28th April, 1863, directing “that Goods being sent  
overseas through a foreign country consigned directly  
to a person or persons resident in a foreign  
country shall be subject to the same duties as if such Goods were imported direct-  
ly into the port of the city where it would be  
desirable that it would be desirable to extend said Order in Council so far as well as di-  
rectly to a person or persons resident in a foreign  
country.”

Whereupon His Excellency in Council was pleased  
to order, and it is hereby ordered, that free  
Goods passing through a foreign country consigned  
directly to Importers in Canada, shall hereafter  
be paid on the same footing as those testing the  
same.
