The "utmost energy" of the American Government, can now do nothing towards saving Lynch, beyond supplicating the Executive clemency on behalf of the doomed man.

It is not to be expected that the representations will lead to a reprieve or a special hearing. In such cases it is usual, in fact, the inevitable rule, to refuse some special reason for the exercise of the Royal prerogative, and we submit that the World might strengthen the influence of the Government by giving it a hint as to the arguments it could with propriety urge, not only on behalf of Lynch but of all the Fenian prisoners.

Let the Washington Cabinet set forth honestly and fully the degree of encouragement which the Fenians in their mad enterprise received from the American people. Let it confess that their society was first patronized by it as a means of exciting recruits for the Northern army, and that they have since been flattered and egged on to deeds of mischief by the two great political parties into which the people of the United States are divided, not in order for the express purpose of injuring and expelling them, but to employ their Irish veterans in honor and get their support on election days.

Finally the petition of the Washington Government should set forth distinctly that had the United States authorities entertained the slightest idea that any danger was likely to have accrued to the Fenians on account of their Fort Erie excursion, they would undoubtedly have interposed in time to have prevented their landing! This would be a very strong point, which would bear amplifying, as the conclusion would therefore be quite logical that the Fenians were in our hands only through an oversight of the American Government, and not through any fault of theirs.

The petition might think very properly wind up with a reference to the expedition and simple mode of entering a *volte-face*, instead of going through a tedious and expensive trial, an example which the American Government had already set, in regard to the leathern arms of these Fenian prisoners.

We ask the World whether in this way its Government might not make out a strong case?
