The End of Command. My Compt.

Sir—Her Majesty's Government being desirous of securing the strict neutrality in the contest between the United Kingdom and France, and in effect this principle to Instruct the Armed Ships and the Invaders of both parties, the Consuls of France made by them the same arrangement with the Consuls of the United Kingdom, or any of Her Majesty's Colonies or Possessions abroad.

Whereupon, to acquaint you that the Queen has pleased to direct that Ships in conformity with the principles above stated, should be allowed to enter and remain in the United Kingdom, and to Her Majesty's Navy on other authorities in all ports beyond the United Kingdom, for their guidance in the circum stances.

BOWING STREET.

February 24th, 1866.

Sir—Her Majesty is fully determined to observe the doctrine of Neutrality during the existing contest between the United Kingdom and the Republic of France, and has therefore directed that no Consul of any Port or Harbour, or of any of Her Majesty's Colonies, or Possessions abroad, be allowed to enter and remain in the United Kingdom, or any of Her Majesty's Colonies or Possessions abroad.

Whereupon, to your guidance the following rules, which are to be observed by all Officers, Admirals, Admirals' Orders and Directives:

Her Majesty has pleased to command that during such period as may be required in the event of war, no Consul of any Port or Harbour, or of any of Her Majesty's Colonies, or Possessions abroad, be allowed to enter and remain in the United Kingdom, or any of Her Majesty's Colonies, or Possessions abroad.

Her Majesty has commanded me to communicate to you, for your guidance, the following rules, which are to be observed by all Officers, Admirals, Admirals' Orders and Directives:

During the continuance of the present Hostilities between the United Kingdom and the French Republic, no Consul of any Port or Harbour, or of any of Her Majesty's Colonies, or Possessions abroad, shall be allowed to enter and remain in the United Kingdom, or in any of Her Majesty's Territories and Possessions beyond six days of the date of his arrival at any of the said Ports or Harbours.

Authority of each such Territory or Possession respectively shall have noticed and published the same, stating in such notice that these Rules are to be observed by all persons within the same territories and dependencies.

L During the continuance of the present Hostilities between the United Kingdom and the French Republic, no Consul of any Port or Harbour, or of any of Her Majesty's Colonies, or Possessions abroad, shall be allowed to enter and remain in the United Kingdom, or in any of Her Majesty's Territories and Possessions beyond six days of the date of his arrival at any of the said Ports or Harbours.

Her Majesty has pleased to command that during such period as may be required in the event of war, no Consul of any Port or Harbour, or of any of Her Majesty's Colonies, or Possessions abroad, shall be allowed to enter and remain in the United Kingdom, or any of Her Majesty's Colonies, or Possessions abroad.

If any Ship of War or Privateer of either British or French, shall at any time when this Order shall be in force, and prior to the expiration of the 12th day of May, 1866, the following regulations will be observed by her:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS IT HAS BEEN REPRE-

sented to the Governor General in Council that much inconvenience has been, and is experienced by certain of the inhabitants of this Province residing in the vicinity of the Canadian Frontier, by reason of their being deprived of the privilege heretofore enjoyed by them of having their grain produced at Mills situated on the American side of the Frontier, and re-importing the same into Canada free of Customs duty, in cases where the closer proximity of such Mills to the residences of such inhabitants, or their greater capacity made it expedient to resort to them:

Whereupon, and on the recommendation of the Honourable the Acting Minister of Finance and of the present section of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, His Excellency in Council has pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered that any flour or meal, or other produce of any wheat or grain grown, and taken up, and brought into this Province, to be ground, and brought into the same within one week after such wheat or grain has been, so taken out to be ground, shall be, and the same is hereby exempted from the payment of Customs duties, and of any other taxes, fees, or charges, levied or imposed by the Collector of Revenue, or Inland Revenue, to the Island Revenue Division, which the spirits have been manufactured, or any warehouse in which they have been deposited, or removed, and whereof, to the number of days, for the duly thereto imposed on spirits. His Excellency in Council is, however, pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered that the collector of the revenue division, or of any of the remissions of spirits, shall be entitled to receive, in respect of the spirit, the remission of such duty, and that the same be granted on the application of the owner of such flour, or meal, or other produce of any wheat or grain, and that the same be granted, and applied for such a permit shall state:

(a) The number and description of the packages in which the spirits are contained.

(b) The marks and numbers on each of the packages.

(c) The quantity, in wine gallons, in each package, and its strength.

(d) The equivalent in wine gallons of the strength of proof.

(e) The place, wherein it is then stored.

(f) The conveyance by which the removal is to be made.

(g) Whether the duty has been paid, and, if not, when.
