TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF OTTAWA.

GENTLEMEN. - At the request of over eight hundred of the bona fide voters of our rising city I am again induced to become a candidate for the honor of representing you in the Parliament of Canada.

In the first place, I desire to express my gratitude for the kind indulgence shown to me by my past conduct through a series of Parliamentary crises, and for the confidence you have been pleased to express that my future course would also be such as to subserve the best interests of our city and to secure for it those improvements which, after fifteen years experience in the great staple trade of our country, I conceive to be absolutely necessary, not only for the welfare of Ottawa, but for the interests of the whole commerce of the country.

I refer, among other things, to the improvement of the Grenville and Carleton Canals. This work I have persistently advocated for the last four years, and I am happy to say that it is now, owing to the exertions of myself and others, being prosecuted, and that the navigation of this part of the river is already greatly improved.

We may also confidently expect that, in the ensuing session of Parliament, an appropriation will be made for the further extension and completion of the work. In connection with this line of navigation, I am also prepared to advocate the construction of the long projected Caughnawaga Canal.

I regard the construction of the OTTAWA and HURON CANALS as a work of real NATIONAL IMPORTANCE which would contribute more than any other undertaking to develop the resources of the whole Dominion, and which would, moreover, greatly tend to accomplish a Western extension of the Confederacy.

I may congratulate you upon the fact that Ottawa has become the seat of Government, not only for the two Provinces of the old Union, but for the Dominion of Canada, which, we may confidently expect, will ere long embrace the whole of British North America; and it may be permitted to me to say that, to secure this great honor for our city, I spared no exertions which you had a right to expect from your representative.

If elected as your representative, I shall deem it to be my duty to support any measures which may be introduced into Parliament for placing the Dominion of the Dominion in a satisfactory condition, and for providing for the maintenance of an adequate Militia or Volunteer force.

Having been a firm supporter of the Government which was specially organized to effect a Confederation of the British North American Provinces, I feel that I should not be studying your interests if I did not pledge myself to support the Ministry which has now been formed for the express purpose of consolidating and putting into operation the new Constitution for the Dominion of Canada.
