

her husband has an authority which, in spite of some fluctuation and uncertainty of judicial decisions, seems to be regulated by the general principles of the law of agency. Agency is a mixed question of law and fact, and the courts will give due weight to such a fact as the possession of property by a married woman without any express or implied direction. Other questions of importance arise in settling the details of such a measure; whether for instance, the poor-liability of the father should be extended to the mother; whether the change should be confined to future marriages only, or should be applied to existing marriages, where after-acquired property is concerned; whether the restrictions imposed by the Massachusetts code on alienation of property by the wife should be adopted; whether the wife's conveyance should be extended to contracts with, or conveyance to or from her husband, or be limited to third parties, as appears to be the case in the American States whose legislation has been referred to; and whether at the death of the wife intestate any part of her personality should go to her next of kin, or the whole to her husband only? These questions, however, require more time for discussion than your issue in this period of the season have been able to devote to them; they therefore recommend that a select committee be appointed in the next session of Parliament for further inquiry.

METROPOLITAN RIFLE ASSOCIATION ANNUAL PRIZE MEETING.

Third Day.

Yesterday morning at 9 o'clock the Association met in the hall of the Hotel de Ville. The twelve prizes being won by the first twelve on the list given below. Besides the scores of the prize-men, we published the list of scores in this column of those who made an average of centres and over. This match was finished early in the afternoon. The Battalion match, the fifth on the programme, was then taken up, and entered upon with great spirit. There were seven battalions entered, as follows: 43rd Battalion, Carleton; Civil Service Regiment; 18th Battalion, Havelock; Ottawa Provisional Battalion; Ottawa Brigade Garrison Artillery; 42nd Battalion, Brockville; and the P. C. O. Rifle Brigade. The 42nd Brockville Battalion made 225 points, winning by ten points the Ottawa Brigade Garrison Artillery, who made 215 points. The highest individual score was made by Sergeant Barry of the Ottawa Rifles, who thereby took the second prize. The match, for which there were 113 entries, was commenced and finished at 5:00 yards. It will likely be finished by eleven today, when matches seven, eight, and ten will probably be shot. The wind will get through with before dark. The entries for the matches already finished have been unusually large which accounts for the seeing scores. For the pool targets there were 459 entries and only 24 bulls' eyes made. The value of each bull's eye is this morning \$1.38. For the pool targets the wind was unfavorable to the shooters.
