There was a very good market on Saturday. In the provision market commodities were in pretty good supply, except butter. Fatness were in abundance, and sold at prices ranging from 23 cents to 25 cents per bushel, and garden vegetables of all kinds were plentiful at moderate prices. Apples are becoming much more plentiful, and sell at our quoted prices.

Butter was less plentiful; old ones having cleared to some extent, and the market depends for its supply on the new crop.

Peanut-A few only were offered, and is becoming somewhat easier.
