THE FINANCES OF QUEBEC, The Quebec Chronicle gives a few reasons why the surplus claimed for this Province is greater than the surplus in fact. In the course of an article on the subject it says:—

The receipts include \$600,000 on Dominion account, but this largely exceeds the regular revenue from the Dominion for this period, not to speak of the deduction to be made for our surplus debt. For the total amount which Quebec receives at present from this source, it is but \$958,000; consequently the revenue of the half year could have been only \$479,000, which was swelled by the Crown Lands revenue and other income to a real total of \$955,677.
