A PROCLAMATION.

Whereas the meeting of our Parliament of Canada stands prorogued to the thirty-first day of the month of March instant, nevertheless, for certain causes and considerations, we have thought fit further to prorogue the same to THIS DAY, the FIFTEENTH day of the month of APRIL next, so that neither of you nor any of you on the said thirty-first day of March instant, at our City of Ottawa, to appear are to be held and constrained, for we will that you and each of you and all others in this behalf interested, that on THURSDAY, the FIFTEENTH day of the month of APRIL next, at our City of Ottawa, aforesaid, personally be and appear for the despatch of business, to treat, do, act and conclude upon those things which in our said Parliament of Canada, by the Common Council of our said Dominion, may by the favor of God be ordained.

In Testimony whereof, we have caused these our letters to be made patent, to the great seal of Canada, to be hereunto affixed. Witness, our trusty and well-beloved, the Right Honourable Sir John Young, Baronet, one of our most honourable Privy Council, Knight Grand Cross of our most honourable order of the Bath, Knight Grand Cross of our most distinguished order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor General of Canada, at our Government House, in our City of Ottawa, in our Dominion the THIRTEENTH day of MARCH, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, and in the thirty-second year of our reign.
