3. No person shall fish for, catch or kill any Bass, Pickerel (Dover) or Mackinno during the months of April and the first day of May, in each year, in the Province of Ontario...

4. No person shall fish for, catch or kill any Speckled (or brook) Trout between the thirtieth day of September and the first day of May, in each year, in the Province of Quebec...

5. No person shall fish for, catch or kill any Salmon-trout during the months of October, November and December, in each year, in the waters of Lake Simcoe...

6. No person shall fish for, catch or kill any Bass, Pickerel (Dover) or Mackinno during the months of April and the first day of May, in each year, in the Province of Ontario...

7. No person shall fish for, catch or kill any Speckled (or brook) Trout between the thirtieth day of September and the first day of May, in each year, in the Province of Quebec...
