SWINDLING ON A LARGE SCALE.

A Clear-tray's Confidence Game. From the Peoria (Ill.) Democrat, June 11. About two years ago an old gentleman, once a prominent railroad man and well known citizen of Peoria, while living in St. Louis, made the acquaintance of a woman, a clairvoyant in that city.

As soon as the marriage ceremony was performed, the three started for Peoria on a bridal tour, and while on the way, the old man was drugged to such an extent as to render him half insane. It seems that the latter had raised and educated an orphan girl. The childish old man, rendered more foolish through the influence of the administered drug, was induced to believe the story that the girl had made affidavit that she had been seduced by an adopted father and that officers of the law were upon the track to arrest the criminal.

The dupe's fortune was principally in cash and Government and railroad bonds. A portion of this he had with him, and a rest was deposited at different places in the East.
