GOVERNMENT HOUSE,
OTTAWA,
Tuesday, 15th day of June, 1899.
PRESENT:
HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.
Whereas by the 12th and 13th sections of the Act 31 Vic. Chap. 50, entitled: "An Act to Increase the Excise duty on spirits, to impose an Excise duty on refined Petroleum, and to provide for the inspection thereof," it is amongst other things enacted, that the Governor in Council may permit the importation, manufacture, sale or disposal of Benzine, and similar products of Petroleum which will not stand the fire test mentioned in the 11th section of that Act, under such regulations as he may deem necessary, and may from time to time, make such regulations respecting the storage of Petroleum, crude or refined, as he may deem necessary to the public safety, making special regulations as to Benzine and other similar products of Petroleum if he sees fit.
His Excellency in Council on the recommendation of the Honourable the acting Minister of Inland Revenue, and under the authority aforesaid, has been pleased to make the following regulations:
1st. In cities and towns where there are Municipal Laws or Regulations respecting the storage of Petroleum and the products thereof—Petroleum, Benzine and all other products of Petroleum—if the duty thereon has been paid, may be stored in any building or place which is in conformity with the Municipal Regulations in that behalf, and when bonded for the duty, they may be stored in such authorized buildings or warehouses as are conformable to the Municipal Regulations.
2nd. In cities and towns where there are no such Municipal Laws or Regulations, or in all villages and places other than cities or towns, Petroleum, Benzine, and all other products of Petroleum, if in quantities exceeding two barrels of crude or refined Petroleum, or ten gallons of Benzine, or any similar article, which will not stand the prescribed fire test, shall be stored only in isolated buildings or premises which are at least two hundred yards distant from the next nearest building not owned or in the occupation of the person to whom the Petroleum, Benzine or other similar article belongs;
Provided always that a license to have in possession and to store refined Petroleum and all the products thereof, shall in each case have been previously obtained from the Inland Revenue Department.

It is hoped that the undertaking will receive the encouragement which its importance deserves. The annual history which the Editor proposes to publish will be of great value to all interested in the future of our country.
Should the Register be as well received as the Editor hopes it will be, he will spare no effort to justify future support. All that labour and impartiality can accomplish will be done to ensure the success of his work. He has been promised assistance by men in different parts of the Dominion whose capacity is undoubted. He intends, with as little delay as possible, to prepare the volumes for 1897 and 1898.

ADDRESS TO THE ELECTORS OF SOUTH RENFREW.
OTTAWA, June 4, 1899.
GENTLEMEN,—
Your requisition inviting me to be a candidate for the representation of South Rensfrew, I have received with gratitude.
