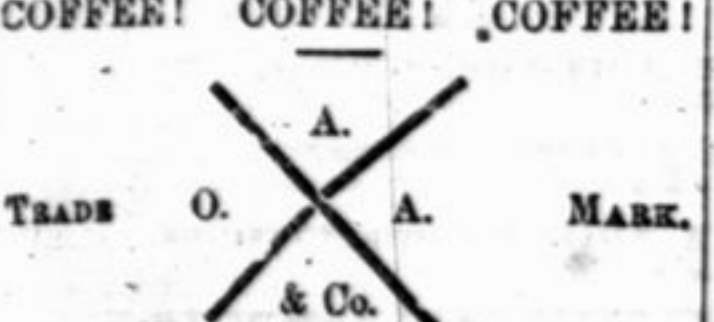

CANADA LIFE ASSURANCE.
