Their Physical Advantages. From the London Medical Times and Gazette. M. Legoyt terminates with the following conclusions an elaborate paper which he recently read at the Parisian Statistical Society.

The facts which are here collected and which are all derived from official sources, are almost unanimous in demonstrating that the Jewish is distinguished from the other European races in a biostatist point of view by the following phenomena: 1. Its general fecundity is less.

2. So it is at least a general rule, with regard to its legitimate fecundity. It is especially so in relation to its natural or illegitimate fecundity.

3. In an equal number of births, there are fewer children born dead, which indicates that the Jewish woman passes through her period gestation more favorably than the Christian woman.

6. The Jews marry earlier than the Christians, and they derive at an early age the advantages which the statistics show are incidental to the married state.
