The news from North Renfrew is as encouraging as the most active supporter of Sir FRANCIS HINCKS could desire. It appears that the FINDLAY men rushed to the polls in the townships where they could count upon their heaviest support, and put out their whole strength yesterday. We are thus enabled to gauge accurately the full strength of the Clear Grits in the county, and the summing up which we give below shows that Sir FRANCIS HINCKS will be returned by a triumphant majority. Westmeath and Ross have polled the whole Findlayite ticket, as will be seen, on the first day, and their majority falls short of the estimated number by no less than 50 to 60 votes.
