WO OR THREE GENTLEMAN

Cost of Census Taking. (From the Montreal Gazette.) We see a paragraph "going the rounds"

stating that the cost of taking the United

States Census, the enumeration of which

has just been completed, is \$957,000. But

this is only for one branch, and the amount

stated is probably not quite accurate. We happen to have before us the table of renumeration paid to "Assistant Marshals" (this is the term applied to Census enumerators in the United States), and from the returns of population which have been published, we calculate that their fees will amount to considerably over \$1,000,000 This, however, is but one portion of the cost of taking a Census. It is not in fact more than one-third of the cost, and we believe that when all the preliminary office expenses are counted, as well as the cost of printing the schedules, manuals, and other forms, with the cost of the Marshals or commissioners, together with that of compilation and printing the resuit in book form, it will be found that the total cost of the United states census will not be under \$3,000,000, but considerably over. This is a large sum; but perhaps not too large, for it must be borne in mind that, in addition to having thirty-eight millions of population, the Ud ed States embrace a very large territory, which is a very important element in the cost of census operation. The mileage of the enumerator must be in some manner paid to him, either directly, or in the fees he is paid for taking the names. If the United States succeed in getting a good census they may get the worth of their money, but this is much more than could be said for their list one, taken ten years ago, which was not much if any better than ours; and we have already seen some signs of grumbling with the present.
