Is hereby given that application will be made to the Legislature of Ontario at its next Session, for an Act to authorise the Canadian Pacific Railway Company, with power to construct a Railway from the Pacific Ocean towards the Rocky Mountains, and from such point as may be selected East of the Rocky Mountains, towards the Pacific Ocean, connecting with the seaboard of British Columbia with the railway system of Canada, and a railway to be constructed upon such road, from such points as its Eastern and Western Terminals, as shall be selected or approved by the Government of Canada, with power also to construct branch lines to the Sault Ste.
