Department of Crown Lands. Toronto, 1st August, 1872. A Sale, by Public Auction, of Timber Berths, on the North Shore of Lake Huron, and North of French River, will be held at the Department of Crown Lands, Toronto, at twelve noon, on TUESDAY the 27th day of October next.

The Berths to be offered for sale are projected Townships, estimated at an area each of thirty six square miles where the outlines are regular; each Township to be put up as one Berth and sold as such, and to be adjudged to the person bidding the highest amount of money per square mile; the amount of money to be paid on the day of sale, by depositing the amount of purchase to the credit of the Department of Crown Lands, in a bank authorized to receive deposits on account of the Government of Ontario.

All Berths sold to be subject to correction with respect to area, under the first clause of the Crown Timber Regulations. Licensees for Berths sold will be issued subject to the Crown Timber Regulations' one month before the outlines are made and payment of bonus and ground rent for current season.

No deduction, from area sold, allowed for water.

The Department reserves the right to one bid on each Berth; and also the right to grant special licenses to cut fuel on the Berths sold, for the supply of coasting steamers.
