Montreal, Sept. 25th, 1874. The sale of Mr. Abbott's farm, stock, Ayrshire, &c., took place on Tuesday morning at 11 AM.

At the approaching session of the Quebec Legislature, a bill will be introduced to incorporate the Western Hospital, to be located in the western section of this city.
