YESTERDAY'S DESPATCHES. SPAIN. The Gustav Outrage.

BRASIL, April 2.—It is stated that Spain has requested Germany to order its vessels to bombard Serana for the Gustav outrage, but Germany refuses because innocent persons will suffer.

UNITED STATES. More Opposition to the Mitchell Demonstrations.

New York, April 2.—A petition signed by O'Donovan Rossa in behalf of the Irish societies of New York, has been presented to the Board of Police in Jersey City on the 11th inst, was rejected by the Police Board of the city.

Death in a Jail.

Albany, N.Y., April 2.—Rufus A. Chase, of Moravia, was taken to a charge of poisoning his wife, died this morning.

Labour Troubles in Massachusetts and New Hampshire.

Boston, Mass., April 2.—Labour troubles are reported in several cotton manufacturing towns in New Hampshire and Maine. The strike at Great Falls, N.H., has not been general, and the Corporation claims that it is now virtually ended. New hands are being easily procured to fill the place of the small proportion of disaffected help. No concession in the price will be made by the mills. At Lowell, Mass., notice of intention to strike was given by the mule spinners only in the Massachusetts, Prescott and Lawrence, while a demand for increased pay was made in all the other mills. The Mule Spinners' Union at Lowell voted not to strike, but upon the receipt of imperative orders from the National Association served their notice upon the mills. The agents have informally declared that the increased demands will not be paid, and the places of the strikers will be filled.

Passage of the Massachusetts Liquor Bill.

The liquor bill, as a substitute for the present prohibitory law, finally passed in the House yesterday, and only requires the Governor's signature to become a law. The bill prohibits the open sale of liquors over the bar, but provides for licenses in connection with hotels and restaurants.

The Salt Lake Polytechnic Trial—A Verdict of Guilt.

Salt Lake, April 2.—The trial of Geo. Reynolds, indicted for polygamy, was concluded yesterday. The jury rendered a verdict of guilty. A few buildings were damaged by the earthquake.

Earthquake in Nevada.

San Francisco, April 2.—A dispatch from Eureka, Nevada, states that there was a heavy shock of earthquake there last evening. A few buildings were damaged and no persons injured.

Captain of Counterfeiters.

St. Louis, Mo., April 2.—Marshall Newcomb received a telegram from Detective Duckworth, stating that he had captured the notorious counterfeit maker, John H. Rankin, Mike Rogers, George Rittenhouse and John Hall, who escaped from the jail here on February 13th.

Negro Chancery Clerk Arrested.

Negro Miss, April 2.—Chancery Clerk Wash Davidson and two other negroes were arrested for fraudulent issues of warrants, and committed to the county jail.

Fire.

Whitehall, N.Y., April 2.—A fire at Fort Henry this morning destroyed several saloons and dwellings, Kiernan's barbers shop and Moorehouse's livery stable, and about \$10,000 worth of property was destroyed.
