A FEARFUL CASE—The Destructive Effects of the Cholera in the United States.
NEW YORK.
New York, Sept. 18.—A despatch from Houston, Texas, says a fearful case has been blowing at Galveston since yesterday morning. The Ocean House on the Gulf Beach is entirely surrounded with water and the outcrops of sand. The city hospital is filled with water. The gale is increasing and the barometer is falling.
